Management demonstrates through policy development that health and safety is their highest priority. Managers and Supervisors are responsible for the implementation and maintenance of Health & Safety Management Systems and Standards within the workplaces under their control, ensuring;

- Any unsafe behaviour is not tolerated,
- All unsafe conditions are immediately corrected,
- All accidents are reported and investigated.

Our beliefs are simply stated as:

- All injuries are preventable,
- No injury is acceptable,
- At Infinity, we will not rank programme, cost or production ahead of an injury free workplace,
- Everyone has the AUTHORITY to stop unsafe work.

Education and Training of all employees on Health and Safety issues is considered to be a natural course of employment and all employees will be encouraged to embrace this concept.

This policy is an outline of the commitment which Infinity Constructions places upon Work Health and Safety within the workplace.

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate to Infinity and the industry.
